



Registration Fee: A registration fee of \$40.00 is due on September 1st, 2024 (\$30.00 for returning dancers).

Payment Options: Payments can be mailed to 50 Lewis St, Dryden, NY 13053 or deposited in the drop box located to the left of the studio door. In-person payments using debit/credit cards are also accepted. Personal checks should be made payable to Tre Realty Management, Inc.

Monthly Tuition Payments: Monthly tuition payments are due during the first week of each month from September to June. Please note, tuition payments are non-refundable and calculated based on 32 weeks per season, not monthly fluctuations. A \$15 late fee applies if payment is not received by the second Thursday of the month. An additional \$20 fee is added for each subsequent week until payment is received. Students with overdue payments beyond the second Thursday will be suspended from classes. There is a \$30.00 fee for returned checks. Please notify us promptly if your child will no longer attend classes to avoid continued charges.

Class Cancellations: Weather-related cancellations will be announced on social media and communicated via email to registered addresses. Studio closures do not necessarily follow school closures; a list of holiday closings will be provided at the beginning of each season. Makeup classes may be offered at alternative times for weather-related closures, subject to scheduling availability. No makeup classes will be scheduled for missed solo/duet/trio sessions without prior arrangement and approval.

Dance Attire/Hair/Shoes: All students must adhere to our dress code policy, wearing appropriate dance attire and shoes. Ballet attire includes leotards (any color) with pink tights and shoes. No jewelry is permitted. Hair must be securely tied back. Specific shoes are required for combo classes, ballet, jazz, tap, and hip hop classes.

Being Prepared for Class & Respectful Behavior: Students are expected to arrive dressed appropriately with hair secured. Respectful behavior toward teachers and peers is mandatory. Failure to comply may result in removal from class. Parents are responsible for ensuring punctuality and readiness. Children must be fully potty-trained to attend classes.

Photographs: We occasionally photograph students in the studio and at events for use on our website and Breeze Dance Company social media pages. By enrolling, parents consent to the use of these photos without entitlement to payment.

Studio Expectations: Students are required to clean up after themselves and use designated spaces for coats and bags. Items should not be left on studio floors or in waiting areas. To ensure a safe environment, **food is strictly prohibited** in the lobby and dance rooms due to severe allergies among our students.

Personal Items: Participants are responsible for their personal belongings brought into the dance studio.

Recital Costumes: Each student is required to purchase a costume for each enrolled class for the end-of-year recital (excluding Conditioning, Tumbling, and Technique classes). Combo class participants will have two costumes. Costume fees typically range from \$50 to \$100, subject to change based on dance style and other factors. Costume fees are due by the last week of October. Parents are responsible for any necessary sewing alterations that may be required.
